

## Kekaulike High School Foundation Scholarships

**Description:** The purpose of this fund is to provide scholarships to King Kekaulike High School graduating seniors who are majoring in any area of study at any accredited post-secondary institution within the US.

**Deadline:** Friday, March 25, 2022, 5:00pm HST

**Eligibility Criteria: Applicants must -**

- Be a resident of the State of Hawai'i
- Be a current year graduating senior of King Kekaulike High School
- Attend an accredited, two or four year institution including other accredited post-secondary vocational-technical schools/programs within the US (including US territories)
- Attend as a full time student (as determined by your school's financial aid office)
- Preference for:
  - Demonstration of financial need
  - Undergraduate student
  - Minimum GPA of 2.5
  - Ten or more hours of community service

**How to apply:**

- Please use this [link](#) to send an automatic request for a letter of recommendation from two adults. It is highly recommended that you send your request at least two weeks prior to the deadline of Friday, March 25, 2022 to ensure submission of letters in a timely manner.

**Other important required information:**

Before completing the application, be prepared to have PDF copies of the following documents:

- A list all of your extra-curricular activities, including sports, community service, part-time jobs, volunteer work, club memberships and offices held on a separate document (Limit to one page, 10-12 font size)
- Personal statements: Responses to three prompts (total of all three responses is limited to only 1 page, typewritten, double spaced, 10-12 font size)
  - The lessons we take from obstacles we encounter can be fundamental to later success. Recount a time when you faced a challenge, setback, or failure. How did it affect you, and what did you learn from the experience?
  - Why do you want to attend a post-secondary institution?
  - Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal growth and a new understanding of yourself or others.
- Your official transcript
- Official SAT and/or ACT scores [if required by the post-secondary institutions you are applying to]
- Your Student Aid Report (SAR) or a copy of the Free Application for Student Aid (FAFSA) form showing your estimated family contribution (EFC)
